As of May, 2024, the NJ Department of Education requires that this new form be completed for all sport physical examinations. This PPE may only be completed by a licensed physician, advance practice nurse (APN) or physician assistant (PA) that has completed the Student-Athlete Cardiac Assessment professional development module. It is recommended that you verify that your medical provider has completed this module before scheduling an appointment for a PPE (Pre-participation Physical Examination).

Once the physical is complete, please return the <u>Medical Eligibility Form</u> to the nurse or athletic office at your students school. PLEASE make sure it is **SIGNED** and **STAMPED** by the physician completing the physical.

Your school physician will confirm receipt of the completed Medical Eligibility Form and a signed clearance letter will be sent to you via email or parent portal.

This form should be maintained by the healthcare provider completing the physical exam (medical home). It should not be shared with schools. The medical eligibility form is the only form that should be submitted to a school. The physical exam must be completed by a healthcare provider who is a licensed physician, advanced practice nurse or physician assistant who has completed the Student - Athlete Cardiac Assessment Professional Development module Hosted by the New Jersey Department of Education.
